The basic criteria of qualifying the abstracts will be their academic value and relevance to the conference topics. Abstracts should not exceed a half A4 page.

The papers accepted for presentation during the conference (max 10 pp) after positive review will be published in the journal *The Socio-Economic Modeling and Forecasting*, which publishes the Proceedings of Professor Aleksander Zelias International Conference on Modelling and Forecasting of Socio-Economic Phenomena. Proceedings will be sent to the **Conference Proceedings Citation Index - Social Science & Humanities (CPCI-SSH)** which is integrated index within **Web of Science™ Core Collection database**. If they are accepted, they will be available in the **Web of Science™ Core Collection** database. Furthermore, the papers from Conference Proceedings are indexed in the Google Scholar.

The conference proceedings of The 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th and 11th *Professor Aleksander Zelias International Conference on Modelling and Forecasting of Socio-Economic Phenomena* have already been included to the **Web of Science™ Core Collection Database** and are indexed in the Google Scholar.

It is also possible to publish an extended version of the paper after positive review in *Entrepreneurial Business and Economics Review (EBER)* or *Central European Journal of Economic Modelling and Econometrics (CEJEME)*, which are indexed in **Emerging Sources Citation Index (ESCI) - Web of Science Database** and **Scopus** or in *Argumenta Oeconomica Cracoviensia* in English (max 16 pp)
